

Summer Food Service Program in Stratton and Eustis 2017

Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Summer Food Service Program will be off and running starting on June 19 and ending on August 10, 2017. Eight weeks, Monday through Thursday at the Stratton School and Cathedral Pines Campground, free meals will be offered to any child 18 years of age and under.

This is a federally funded program to provide a free nutritious breakfast, lunch and snack while school is not in session. Any child 18 years of age and under can attend. If age appropriate, stay for the Eustis Summer Rec Program (K-9th only) which goes hand and hand with the Summer meals program.

Breakfast will be served at the Stratton School, 65 School Street in Stratton from 7:30am- 8:00am sharp. (NO meals served after 8 , if attending the Rec programs the bus leaves promptly at 8am)

Parents/Guardians of children 10 and under must stay with their child, help them with their meal, clean up after them, stay with them until they board the bus. Older children must be instructed to clean up after themselves, then go and join their group. Parents/Guardians please remind your child that food must be eaten on site (allow enough time for your child to eat) as no food may be taken off site (except for one fruit or veggie).

Lunch and snack will be served at the Cathedral Pines Campground. Lunch from 11:30am to 12:00pm. Snack is served from 2:45pm to 3:00pm. Meals must be eaten on site with no food leaving (except for whole fruits or veggies). Menu subject to change without notice.

The only date when lunch will be served at school is July 27. To check dates for venue change due to weather or unforeseen events please contact: Melissa Pare' at mpare@strattonschool.org or phone the Stratton School at 246-2283, (email is best).

The program will run on Tuesday July 4th with a BBQ and events at the Cathedral Pines. What do you need to do? Just show up as usual.

Rec program: To sign up contact Amber at: amber.gellman@gmail.com or call 207-491-1779. The Rec program is free to children from Stratton, Eustis and Coplin, non-residents pay a weekly fee. So get signed up, get a good meal and have fun for eight weeks this summer.

1. **NO ADULT MAY TAKE PART IN THIS PROGRAM, NO FOOD MAY BE EATEN OR TAKEN OFF SITE BY ANY ADULT.**
2. CHILDREN MAY TAKE OFF SITE ONLY ONE PIECE OF FRUIT or veggie to take to beach.
3. NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED IN GYM UNLESS SITTING AT A TABLE.
4. CHILDREN MUST TAKE 3 FOOD ITEMS, ONE MUST BE A FRUIT OR VEGGIE
5. ADULTS MUST STAY & HELP KIDS 10 AND UNDER, CLEAN UP AFTER THEM, DIRECT THEM TO JOIN THEIR GROUP. PLEASE DO NOT LET YOUR CHILD RUN AROUND UNATTENDED. OLDER KIDS MUST CLEAN UP THEMSELVES THEN JOIN THEIR GROUPS AS WELL.
6. BUS LEAVES AT 8AM SHARP BE ON TIME!
7. NO CLIMBING OR SITTING ON BLEACHERS WHEN THEY ARE CLOSED. DO NOT LEAVE TRASH BEHIND, ALL KIDS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO PICK UP AFTERTHEMSELVES.
8. SCHOOL CUSTODIANS ARE **NOT** RESPONSIBLE FOR EITHER PROGRAM CLEAN UP SO PLEASE HELP OUT.
9. ENCOURAGE KIDS TO COME AND HAVE BREAKFAST, REC IS A FAST PACED DAY!

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
