## SCHOOL INFORMATION

Dear Parents:

As we head into the colder weather and snow in the next six-week forecast, I would like to review a few things and remind you of some upcoming events.

\*First, reviewing our drop off/pick up and parking procedures. For the morning and at the end of the day, the big loop of the driveway is open and may be used for drop off and pick up. It is only during the regular part of the day (after the first bell until the buses line up at 2 PM) that we ask parents to use the entrance off School Street extension. As a reminder however, you should not pass a school bus with its red light on, even in the school parking lot.

When using the School Street extension entrance, if you are going into the building, please pull through and park in the painted parking spots so as not to block the entrance or flow of traffic for dropping off. The designated parking spaces will be re-painted over the Columbus Day weekend and will be more noticeable.


