Dear Parents:

Last Friday, January 28th, we had our first ski and ride opportunity of the year. It was great to have most of the school take advantage of this great program that Sugarloaf graciously offers to our students, staff and volunteers. Overall, it was a great success.

There were several things, however, that need some clarification and are listed below.

- Students are provided a two-hour lesson in the afternoon, then have approximately 30-45 minutes to have a snack and return for an additional run or two. All students are in groups accompanied by a staff member.
- Upon arrival at the mountain, students will drop their personal belongings inside the rental shop, go to lessons, take a run or two with a staff/volunteer but be back no later than 3:45 p.m. At the end of the afternoon's program, all students and staff meet at 3:45 p.m. at the flag pole out front of the rental shop.
- Parents can either pick their child up at the flagpole or back at school at approximately 4:15. Prior to leaving the mountain, all students must check in with assigned staff so all students are accounted for.

It is obvious students are enjoying learning the life-long recreational activity of skiing and riding, and the growth they are making is incredible to see. Thanks to everyone for supporting such an excellent opportunity.
