  - 2. Covid-19 Update SOP's are posted on the Website. If tested positive, people are out only 5 days instead of 10. The pool testing allows to identify positive cases quickly. We have 85% people in pool testing and 68% of students and staff are vaccinated.
  - 3. High School Options Barry recently held two zoom meetings with parents. One day with PreK-4 and the other day with 5-8 grades. This zoom meeting was just to have a general conversation. There is some anxiety with parents about the state of MSAD #58. On January 19<sup>th</sup>, from 4:30 6:00, Georgia Campbell of Rangeley School, will hold a tour of the school for parents wishing to attend. This is a work in progress. We will visit Rangeley as well as MSAD #58 at a later date.
  - 4. Girls & Boys Basketball Coach: John Walker and Caitlin Wyman are great candidates for the positions and have agreed to take on the Boys and Girls coaching positions. Barry is hoping that the board will approve these two candidates tonight.

Barry brought up Ski/Skate. If students have snowboarded before, they would be allowed to during Ski/Skate. There will not be lessons or an instructor.

We will not be going to the Outdoor Center for Skating. Those left behind will go to the town park skating rink that afternoon, like an extended P.E. class.
