


Stratton School students have had a great first month at school. Together as a class community we have been developing our classroom expectations following ROAR. We will continue to review these throughout the year.

WHAT IS PBIS?

Positive Behavioral Interventions & Supports is an evidence based tiered framework for supporting students' behavioral, academic, social, emotional, and mental health. PBIS can improve social emotional competence, academic success, and school climate.



SCHOOL WIDE RECOGNITION-PAWS:

This year we have transitioned our school wide positive behavior recognition to PAWS. Students earn PAWS when they are demonstrating the ROAR expectations.

PAWS are read and students are recognized during the daily morning announcements. Students will be bringing home the PAWS they received so you can celebrate at home as well!

We have a school wide goal of 333 PAWS each trimester, and 1,000 for the school year. If we reach these goals we will have a whole school reward to celebrate!
